## Data Breach Notification Policy

Estate Valuations & Pricing Systems does not transmit or store customer-confidential data -- EstateVal sends only security identifiers and evaluation dates to the EVP data center; not names, account numbers or lot sizes. However we take data security seriously and value the information that we have been entrusted with, including client contact phone numbers, e-mail conversations and other details of doing business.

Accordingly, if an authorized intruder does breach our the security of our computer systems, we will notify the affected clients as soon as possible, using one or more of the follow methods:

- Via Message Center. The EVP Office Message Center allows messages to be sent to our client software installations and presented to the user, either all at once or on a per-account or per-user basis. After a data breach, details will be provided through Message Center at the appropriate granularity, including a link to a detailed Web posting.
- Via e-mail or the post, specifically the contact details we have in our client database. After a data breach, e-mail will be sent to the affected clients that have an address on record with us; otherwise postal mail will be sent. The URL of a page detailing the breach will be included.
- Via our website. A post will be made on the front page -- and later stored in the archives -- detailing the breach, who was affected, how the problem was remediated and what steps have been taken to prevent the intrusion from happen again.
